ORDER

The undersigned's Order dated December 22, 2006 shall be, and the same hereby is, **AMENDED** to read as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that the following briefing schedule be, and the same hereby is, established for all social security cases filed on or after January 1, 2007 once the defendant has filed an answer and a certified copy of the transcript of the administrative record where, pursuant to Local Rule 83.11(c)(1), judicial review will be on written motion,

(1) The plaintiff must move for summary judgment or judgment on the pleadings within sixty (60) days of the filing of the answer and administrative transcript, together with a supporting memorandum which shall not exceed 15 pages in length.

(2) The Commissioner must file a countermotion or a response to the plaintiff's motion within thirty (30) days of the filing of the plaintiff's motion for summary judgment or judgment on the pleadings, which countermotion or response shall not exceed 15 pages in length.

(3) Extensions of time, expansions of page limitations, or permission to file additional briefs may be granted only if good

cause is shown.

Nothing in this Order shall preclude the presiding judge to whom a social security case is assigned from electing to conduct judicial review pursuant to LR 83.11(c)(2).

The Clerk shall file a copy of this Order in all impacted cases.
