RE: INCREASED FEES FOR RESTRICTED DELIVERY SERVICE OF PROCESS

Pursuant to KRS 454.210, the Office of the Secretary of State serves process on out-of-state residents and requires that this service be sent by certified mail for \$10.00.

Some parties elect to send their service of process by **certified mail restricted delivery**. This office accommodates such requests as long as the requesting party pays the certified mail restricted delivery mailing fee in addition to the \$10.00 statutory fee. Although this office makes every effort to absorb fee increases, upcoming changes in the U.S. Postal Service's ("USPS") fee schedule necessitate a change in our office's practice.

Effective January 26, 2020, the USPS **increased** the restricted delivery charge to \$5.45. On this same day, the Office of the Secretary of State **increased** its fee for restricted delivery to \$5.45. Thus, each request to send service of process by certified mail restricted delivery that is received by this office on or after February 28, 2020, must be accompanied by a check or money order for \$15.45 (the statutory fee plus the restricted delivery fee).

We appreciate your office providing notice of this change to all interested parties who may wish to use certified mail restricted delivery.
