## GENERAL ORDER 08- 19

## IN RE: SERVICE OF PETIT JURORS and GRAND JURORS

\* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \* \*

Effective January 1, 2009, by unanimous consensus of the active Judges of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Kentucky, **IT IS**ORDERED as follows:

- 1. Petit Jurors shall complete their service requirement upon service of either twenty (20) days or six (6) months, whichever occurs first.
- 2. The six (6) months period of service shall begin the first date the petit juror is notified to appear and end six (6) months after that date.
- The six (6) months period shall be extended by the number of days the petit juror is excused during their term of service.
- 4. This General Order applies to all petit jurors, including the current wheel (2007-2008.)
- An active petit juror, with an appearance date prior to
  January 1, 2009, shall have the six (6) month period of service calculated from their first appearance date.
- Grand Jurors shall be impaneled for a term of twelve (12) months.
  The one (1) year term for Grand Jurors shall begin with the 2009
  Grand Jury term.
