ORDERED as follows:

Due to an increased number of cases involving individuals infected with the COVID-19 virus in both the general public and in detention facilities located within this district, and for reasons outlined in prior general orders relating to the COVID-19 pandemic, General Order No. 20-10, entered June 3, 2020, is **EXTENDED** to authorize the continued use of video conferencing, or telephone conferencing if video conferencing is not reasonably available, for **ALL EVENTS** listed in Section 15002(b) of The CARES Act, Pub. L. No. 116-136, 134 Stat. 281. Pursuant to Section 15002(b)(3) of the legislation, this authorization will remain in effect through September 30, 2020, unless terminated earlier.

The authorization allowed by this general order will be again reviewed at or near its date of termination to determine if a further extension is warranted based on conditions existing at that time.
